A Case Study in Savings and Efficiency

Rivian – a producer of electric truck, vans, and SUVs – runs a state-of-the-art manufacturing facility in Normal, Illinois.

As a relatively new start-up with a range of supply chain challenges, they had been investigating ways to have assembled components delivered directly to the production line.

In June of 2022, they approached Peoria Production Solutions for help with a specific challenge they had with the production of 125,000 EV delivery vans for Amazon.

At the time, Rivian workers were assembling cargo bay fans for the vans onsite just prior to installation.

The process had become a chokepoint and was slowing down the entire production line. They reached out to see if we had the capability to assemble the cargo fan and the workforce in place to ensure continuity of supply. The answer to both questions was yes.

After a series of trials with engineers from Rivian we were ready to go ahead with assembly. Currently, we are producing 90% of the total fan units needed for the Amazon van project.

As a value-added service, we are also purchasing the fan components for assembly at our facility - saving Rivian both time and money.
