Sustainability Initiatives

At Peoria Production Solutions, sustainability is more than just a buzzword. We are committed to sustainability and have taken action to reduce our impact on the environment.

Lighting the Way

All of the energy needs for our facility on West Townline Road in Peoria are met by solar power. Lights, heating, and cooling are powered by our roof mounted solar panels. We use less energy than we produce, and routinely sell the excess to the electric company.

We have upgraded to efficient lighting in both facilities and are doing our part to help the environment.

Reducing Upstream Waste

- We recycle paper and cardboard at both facilities.
 Midwest Fiber purchases the compacted cardboard and paper to sell to producers of recycled paper.
- Clear plastic and plastic banding from deliveries we receive are recycled.
- Our plant and office staff have separate recycling containers for paper and plastic bottles. Aluminum cans are also collected and taken to a local drop-off point.
- Whenever possible, we reuse wooden skids for outbound shipments, broken, unusable skids (20 per week on average) are sent to a local company for chipping into mulch.
- We dispose of electronics responsibly. Electronics are taken to Kuusakoski Recycling in Peoria. They salvage and recycle useable components and otherwise safely dispose of computer terminals, monitors, televisions, etc.
